Process of Filing Nomination papers

Step3: Enter your Login User Id and Password


Step4: Click on the Nomination Tab

- N.B:**
1. Candidates must submit their Photocopy of HSLC Admit card / Pass Certificate along with the Nomination papers.
 2. On the day of scrutiny of nomination papers, candidates must have to submit original Admit card of HSLC examination.
 3. Printed copy of the filed nomination papers duly signed by the candidates, Proposer and seconder must be submitted to election office before 10.30 am on 02-02-2024.
 4. Incomplete nomination papers will be summarily rejected.
 5. The portfolio of Gymnasium has been abolished subject to the amendment of election rules.
 6. The portfolio of Vice-president is reserved for girl students.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

ELECTION TO THE STUDENTS' UNION

SESSION-2023-24

JAWAHARLAL NEHRU COLLEGE: BOKO

1. E-Nomination forms are available in the college portal.
2. A candidate may contest for one portfolio only in Union Election. (as per the verdict of the Honorable Supreme Court)
3. A Student may propose or support one candidate only.
4. Students of H.S. classes are not allowed to contest the election but allowed to cast votes.
5. TDC 5th & 6th Semester and students of PG classes are not allowed to contest the Election.
6. Only Regular Students (minimum attendance 75 %) are allowed to contest.
7. For age proof, photo copy of Admit Card/ Pass Certificate of HSLC Examination must be furnished along with nomination paper.
8. Age of candidate must be between 17 and 22 years. (as per the verdict of the honorable Supreme Court)
9. The candidates shall have one opportunity to contest for the post of office bearer.
10. There is no provision for contesting the election for previous contestants and office bearers of the students' union.
11. No Candidate shall be permitted to make the use of printed posters, Pamphlets or any other printed materials for the purpose of canvassing. (as per the verdict of the honorable Supreme Court)
12. No Candidate will be allowed to Deface or Damage the College property during canvassing. (as per the verdict of the Honorable Supreme Court)
13. Candidate having criminal records will not be allowed to contest the Election. (as per the verdict of the Honorable Supreme Court)
14. The Maximum permitted Expenditure must not exceed Rs. 5000/- and each candidate shall within two weeks of the declaration of the result submit complete accounts of election expenditure to the Election officer.
15. All Candidates shall be responsible for ensuring the cleaning up of the polling area within 48 hours of the conclusion of polling.
16. Any complaint relating to the election must be brought to the notice of the election officer in Black and White.
17. The decision of the election committee will be final for any controversy regarding the election.
18. The entire election process should be completed within ten (10) days from the date of promulgation of election notification.
19. At the time of scrutiny of nomination papers, candidates must produce the original HSLC admit card for authentication of his/her age.
20. The students of college must wear college uniform and bring their identity card on the day of election.
21. If any portfolio remains uncontested, then the Principal of the college has the discretion to nominate a student for the same.
22. **VOTING WILL BE DONE THROUGH ELECTRONIC MODE.**
